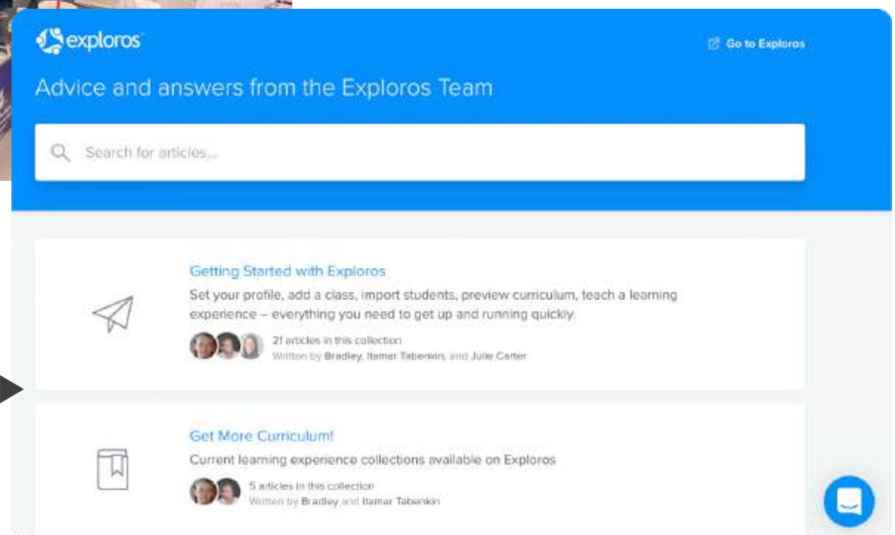

Implementation Framework

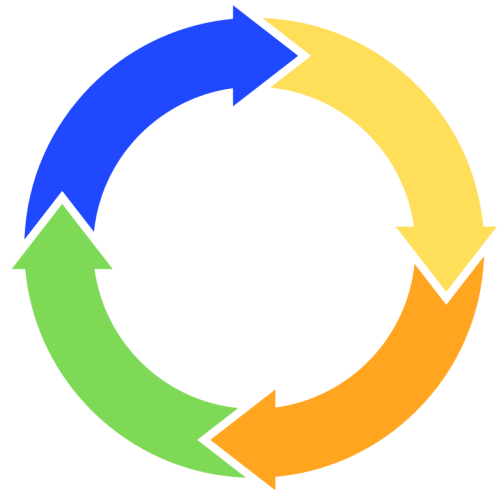

Implementation Phases

Phases Within Each Year

Phase	Months	Focus Areas
● Plan & Prepare	March–May	Goal-setting, administrator alignment, and training.
● Getting Ready for the Year	May–June	Curriculum planning workshops and lesson internalization training.
● Starting the School Year	July–August	Teacher onboarding, class rostering, and launch training.
● Teaching & Supporting	August–March	Ongoing coaching, best practices, data training, and PLC support.
